Pursuant to sections 5103.03, 5153.16, 5153.166 and 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC 5101:2-42-66 entitled Administrative procedures for comprehensive health care for children in placement sets forth the requirements for a comprehensive health care screening and services for Medicaid-eligible children in substitute care. This rule has been amended to clarify guidance on tracking the information given to the substitute caregiver pertaining to healthchek services and transportation services.

OAC 5101:2-42-66.1 entitled Comprehensive health care for children in placement sets forth the requirements to coordinate health care services for children in substitute care as a child enters a substitute care setting or experiences a placement change. This rule has been amended to implement provisions of the Family First Prevention Services Act, Public Law 115-123 to align the rule with law regarding the age of the child(ren) and the services and timeframes to conduct age appropriate medical, dental, vision, behavioral, auditory and developmental examinations.

OAC 5101:2-42-66.2 entitled Documentation of comprehensive health care for children in placement sets forth the requirements of documenting and maintaining a record of all physical, developmental and psychological assessments and treatments for each child in the care or custody of a private child placing agency or private non-custodial agency. This rule was amended to include a source of a child's health information may come from a Medicaid Managed Care Plan.
