PUBLIC NOTICE

The Ohio State Racing Commission will hold a public hearing for the purpose of accepting testimony on the proposed amended rule package containing rules found in Chapter 14 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

These rules discuss permit holders' requirements in Standardbred horse racing. These rules were reviewed in accordance with the requirement of Ohio Revised Code 119.03 and have proposed as follows:

- Ohio Administrative Code 3769-14-05 titled Conflict in Interest. This rule is being amended to exempt outriders from this rule.
- Ohio Administrative Code 3769-14-19 titled Visual Recording. This rule is being amended to remove a grammar error.
- Ohio Administrative Code 3769-14-44 titled Equipment Record. This rule is being amended to add microchip information to the required records and to remove some grammar errors.
- Ohio Administrative Code 3769-14-47 titled Timers. This rule is being amended to remove the requirement of the permit holders to have a person with a stopwatch timing the race.
- Ohio Administrative Code 3769-14-54 titled Expanded Homestretch Racing. This rule is being amended to remove a grammar error.
