Pursuant to section 4141.13 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon. The rules below are proposed as amended as a result of the five year review process, and for language content changes for clarity.

4141-25-09: "Director's authority to request information regarding labor disputes."

This rule states upon request, the employer shall furnish names, social security numbers, and other information necessary to determine whether the reason for unemployment of individuals was due to a lockout or a labor dispute other than a lockout.

4141-43-02: "Disclosure of confidential information to public child support enforcement agencies, public assistance agencies, employment and training agencies, prosecuting authorities, and other public officials and governmental agencies."

This rule states confidential wage, claim, employer and/or employment and training information furnished to or maintained by the director of the department of job and family services pursuant to Chapter 4141. of the Revised Code may be disclosed or exchanged with county departments of job and family services, state and county child support enforcement agencies, and governmental agencies administering employment and training and public assistance programs to ensure the programs are administered properly.
