Pursuant to section 4141.13 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

The rules below are proposed to be amended as a result of the five year review process, and for language content clarity.

OAC 4141-7-04: “Voluntary election applying to successor-in-interest in whole or in part.”

The successor-in-interest, in whole or in part, is bound by the voluntary election of the previous employer, which remains in effect regardless of the ownership of the business for a minimum of two calendar years from the effective date.

OAC 4141-35-03: “Exception to benefit charges.” Any exception to benefit charges under division (D) of section 4141.24 of the Revised Code is to be in writing and filed with the department within fifteen days after the notice of benefit charges is issued to the employer. The exception to charges is to be submitted by the employer or authorized representative and include the issue date of the notice to which the exception is being taken.
