Pursuant to R.C. 119.032, state agencies are required to review all agency rules every five years to determine whether to amend the rules, rescind the rules, or continue the rules without change. Due to such review, the Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) is proposing the following:

Amending:

4123-6-02.2 Provider access to the HPP - provider certification criteria

4123-6-21.3 Outpatient medication formulary.

4123-6-21.6 First fill of outpatient medications.

Enacting:

4123-6-21.7 Reimbursement of opioids in the treatment of pain for a work related injury or occupational disease.

4123-6-21.8 Reimbursement for services to assist in the discontinuation of medications.

Rescinding:

4123-6-21.7 Utilization of opioids in the subacute or chronic phases of pain treatment for a work-related injury or occupational disease.

Further, BWC is amending the following rule to correct a cross reference found in paragraph (D) of the following rule:

4123-18-04 Living maintenance allowance.
