• 3301-20-03 Employment of non-licensed individuals with certain criminal convictions. (Rescind/New)

The rule is being rescinded in its current form and replaced in order to align the rehabilitation standards under the rule with the standards applicable to licensed school employees pursuant to OAC 3301-20-01.

• 3301-91-02 Schedule of payments. (Amend)

The rule has been amended to insert a citation to the federal regulations governing the National School Lunch Program. The rule was further amended to update the terminology from "needy children" to "eligible children" and to reflect the Department's current practice that state fund matching payments are made annually, rather than monthly, beginning in the fiscal year for which the funds are appropriated.

• 3301-91-03 Report required. (Amend)

The rule has been amended to insert a citation to the federal regulations governing the National School Lunch Program and to clarify that the reports shall be submitted to the Ohio Department of Education.

• 3301-98-01 Reimbursement of Background Checks for Individuals Participating in the OhioReads Classroom Reading Grants Program. (Rescind)

This rule amplified Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3301.88 and 3301.86, both of which were repealed under House Bill 477 of the 132nd General Assembly, effective April 8, 2019.
