UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION REVIEW COMMISSION  
PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission intends to conduct a public hearing for the purpose of amending Ohio Administrative Code Section 4146-5-04 Notice of Hearing, 4146-5-08 Documents to be considered in telephone hearings, 4146-15-04 Who may be allowed witness fees; amount and 4146-15-05 Amount of mileage fees.

The proposed change to 4146-5-04, the change simply corrects a typographical error in the section, changing the word “part” to “party”.

The proposed change to 4146-5-08, the change eliminates the current, arbitrary fourteen-day time limit for filing documents, and instead states simply that documents must be filed no later than the day prior to the hearing date.

The proposed change to 4146-15-04, we have added the words in section 119.094 of the revised code, we have removed the words by law in civil cases.

The proposed change to 4146-15-05, we have added the words prescribed in section 119.094 of the revised code, we have removed the words of ten cents.

The Unemployment Compensation Review Commission shall hold a telephonic public hearing in order to receive and hear comments on the proposed rules **from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, on Wednesday, July 1, 2020**. The hearing will be held by telephone in response to directives from the Ohio Department of Health and Governor Mike DeWine. Any person affected by the proposed rule may present their comments telephonically, or in writing. For those wishing to participate, please choose from the following options:
