Appendix 2 – INSTANT BINGO FUNDRAISING CONTRACT WITH VETERAN'S, FRATERNAL, OR SPORTING ORGANIZATIONS

L. Entire Agreement. This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. This Contract supersedes any and all previous agreements, whether written or oral, between the parties. Neither party may modify or amend the terms of this Contract except to modify or amend the distribution percentage and/or distribution schedule (section (B)(4)). A modification or amendment to the distribution percentage or distribution schedule shall be made in writing and signed by both parties and sent to the Attorney General.

All interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and present oral and/or written testimony.
