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FEDERAL MEDICAID NOTICE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID

Pursuant to 42 CFR 447.205, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (department) gives notice of the department's intent to change its methods and standards for Medicaid payment for targeted case management (TCM) provided by a substance use disorder provider certified or licensed by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS).

The department is correcting the state plan to remove registered nurses (RN) and licensed practical nurses (LPN) from the list of eligible providers of TCM provided by a substance use disorder provider certified or licensed by OhioMHAS. Their inclusion in the state plan was an error as they are not eligible providers of this service.

Implementation of this change in the methods and standards for setting payment rates is expected to have no impact on annual aggregate expenditures for TCM provided by a substance use disorder provider certified or licensed by OhioMHAS.
