

**LEGAL NOTICE
STATE OF OHIO
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID**

Pursuant to section 1902(a)(13)(A) of the Social Security Act, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (department) gives final notice of the department's intent to obsolete the provisions relating to the methodology for calculating and making supplemental payments for inpatient and outpatient hospital services.

An initial notice was issued on February 3, 2020 to inform the public of the Department's intent to obsolete the provisions relating to supplemental upper limit payments. This final notice reflects the result of the public and legislative processes.

The department recently updated the reimbursement methodology for making inpatient and outpatient payments to hospitals. This update utilized funding previously used to support the supplemental upper limit payments; therefore, these supplemental payment methodologies are no longer needed. These updated hospital payment policies are designed to ensure adequate access to hospital services for Medicaid recipients.
