This rule is proposed to clarify that a veterans or fraternal organization is not required to actually obtain a license to conduct a bingo session in order to be licensed to conduct instant bingo other than at a bingo session pursuant to R.C. 2915.13

The rule provides that for purposes of R.C. 2915.13, "authorized to conduct a bingo session" means eligible to obtain a license to conduct a bingo session, but does not mean licensed.

The total fiscal impact is unknown, since the numbers of veterans and fraternal organization that will apply only for a license to conduct instant bingo other than at a bingo session is unknown. However, revenues could be reduced by an estimated \$100,000 annually if 500 such organizations choose not to apply for a license to conduct a bingo session.

Implementation of the rule will not place additional burdens on the Attorney General with respect to the enforcement of R.C. Chapter 2915.

The proposed rule does not impose additional requirements on charitable organizations; therefore, the estimated cost of compliance reduced by as much as \$200 annually for those organizations that choose to apply only for a license to conduct instant bingo other than at a bingo session.
