The rule sets forth the time limit in which a State employee that is eligible for disability benefits has to apply for such benefits if the State employee is disability separated from employment. The proposed amendment corrects some cross-references in the first paragraph and adds language that provides that a State employee who is disability separated from employment is no longer eligible to recieve "occupational injury leave" or "salary continuation" if the State employee had been receiving either prior to being separated.
