Sets forth who is responsible for determining a lack of funds and who is responsible for determining a lack of work for appointing authorities whose employees are paid by a warrant of the State of Ohio. The rule also restricts the verification of retention points until the applicable determination has been made. The rule is being changed to reflect that the Director of Budget and Management, not the Auditor of State, now issues warrants of the State of Ohio. It is also being clarified so that the general reference to a "director" is being made specific to the Director of Adminstrative Services. Finally, a clarification is being added regarding a lack of work to add that the comparison can also include projected work levels in relation to work levels when a lack of work did not exist.
