## 123:1-41-22 Cash conversion of accrued leave at layoff, and restoration of leave credit.

- (A) General. Any employee who is eligible for a cash conversion of their accumulated leave and who is laid off shall may have his or her accumulated balances of vacation, personal leave, and sick leave converted to a cash benefit according to the following:
  - (1) Sick leave and personal leave. Any accumulated unused balances of sick leave and personal leave shall may be converted to cash in accordance with the rules established in Chapter 123:1-32 of the Administrative Code; and
  - (2) Any accumulated unused balance of vacation shall <u>may</u> be converted to a cash payment at the time an employee is laid off.
    - Payment of any cash conversion made to employees paid by warrant of the director of budget and management shall be made according to the provisions of Chapter 123:1-32 of the Administrative Code and the procedures established by the director.
- (B) Reinstatement of leaves. Employee's leave balances may only be reinstated if the employee's layoff is disaffirmed by the state personnel board of review and the employee submits a reimbursement for the entire amount of the leave balance previously converted.
