123:1-44-01 **Holidays.** 

- (A) An employee <u>who</u> that is not in active pay status for the entire scheduled work day immediately preceding the holiday shall not receive holiday compensation, <u>except</u> <u>as provided in paragraph (B) of this rule</u>.
- (B) An employee need not be in active pay status on the scheduled work day immediately preceding a holiday in order to be paid for the holiday if the employee is participating in a mandatory cost savings day or a voluntary cost savings day pursuant to section 124.392 of the Revised Code.
- (B)(C) Section 124.19 of the Revised Code does not provide for shifting the day on which a holiday is observed to any other day, with the exception of designated holidays at universities.
- (C)(D) An appointment into the classified or unclassified service of the state should not be made effective on a holiday unless the employee is scheduled to work on that day.
