UST Inspector training courses offered by the fire marshal have historically been free of charge to members of participating fire departments. Certified UST Inspectors must renew every 2 years at a cost of \$25, plus the cost of any required refresher training course established by the fire marshal. UST Inspector refresher training courses offered by the fire marshal have historically been free of charge to members of participating fire departments.
