ODA-administered programs during the federal COVID-19 public health emergency.

For any rule in Chapter 173-3, 173-4, or 173-39 of the Administrative Code over an ODA-administered program paid, in whole or in part, with federal funds with regulatory relief or flexibility in effect during a state of emergency declared by the governor, the regulatory relief or flexibility is hereby declared to remain in effect until the federal public health emergency ends, unless a federal law or federal funding agency authorizes extending the regulatory relief or flexibility after the end of the federal public health emergency.

The relief from disenrollment during a state of emergency declared by the governor in paragraph (A)(1) of rule 173-40-03 of the Administrative Code and paragraph (A)(1) of rule 173-51-03 of the Administrative Code is hereby declared to remain in effect until the end of the public health emergency, unless a federal law or federal funding agency authorizes extending the regulatory relief or flexibility after the end of the federal public health emergency.
