 - (J)(10) Region 10A: Lake, Cuyahoga, Geauga, Medina, and Lorain counties;
 - (K)(11) Region 10B: Wayne, Stark, Portage, and Summit counties; and,
 - (L)(12) Region 11: Ashtabula, Trumbull, Mahoning, and Columbiana counties.
- (B) Nothing in this rule shall preclude one regional program from providing ombudsman services in another region, upon request by the SLTCO, provided adequate resources are made available.
