This new rule is being proposed as part of a five-year rule review performed pursuant to section 119.032 of the Revised Code and because most of the rules of Chapter 173-35 of the Administrative Code are undergoing change as a result of language in Am. Sub. H. B. No. 119 (127th G. A.). This new rule is being proposed to replace the waiting list language and the enrollment language in rules 173-35-03 and 173-35-05 of the Administrative Code, which are being proposed for rescission.

The proposed new rule outlines the process for enrolling an individual into the RSS program, including the process for placing a person on and removing a person from the waiting list to enroll into the RSS program.

On October 16, 2007, this rule proposed for rescission was revised-filed, but the rule was not revised. Instead, the content of the RSFA was made more complete.

On November 16, 2007, ODA revised this rule by making the following changes:

In paragraph (A), the words "to apply" were replaced by "enroll in." At the end of the first line of the paragraph, the semicolon and comma were deleted. The words "two or more members of" were replaced by "an individual and one or more members of the individual's."

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In paragraph (B), "pursuant to paragraph (A) of this rule" was deleted.

In paragraph (B)(2), the word "each" was replaced by "the."

In paragraph (B)(2)(a), the words "and date of request for consideration for enrollment in the RSS program" was deleted because it repeated paragraph (B)(1) of the same rule. Additionally, "and" was added before the word "social."

In paragraph (B)(4), the following phrase was deleted as it occurred after the word "list": "and complete form JFS 07120 ('Residential State Supplement') on behalf of the individual and submit it to a CDJFS on behalf of the individual in accordance with Chapter 5101:1-17 of the Administrative Code."

In paragraph (C)(1), the word "occurs" was replaced by the words "shall only occur after."

Paragraph (C)(2) was reworded and formed into paragraph (C)(2) and (C)(3). The order of how one is to be removed from the waiting list was adjusted, as noted in those paragraphs.

The words "Prior to enrollment," were inserted at the beginning of paragraph (D) and the words "once it has selected an individual from the waiting list" were deleted from the end of that paragraph.

The language of paragraph (D)(1) was improved without changing the meaning of the paragraph.

In paragraph (D)(2) of this proposed new rule, "Assess" was replaced by "Determine."

In paragraph (D)(3), these words were added to the end of the paragraph: ", and verify whether the CDJFS has determined if the individual meets the medicaid financial eligibility criteria."

Paragraphs (D)(4) and (D)(5) were combined, with the following results: the words "a facility" was replaced by the words "an approved living arrangement that is capable of meeting that is." Also, the words ", in accordance with rule 173-35-05.1 of the Administrative Code" was inserted after "needs." Additionally, the words "placement in" were replaced by the words "admission to."

In paragraphs (E)(1) and (E)(2), "less" was replaced by "later" and "assessment" was replaced by "determination."

This RSFA was updated.
