## <u>173-39-02.18</u> Non-medical transportation.

- (A) "Non-medical transportation" (transportation) means using a provider's vehicle and driver to transport individuals from one place to another for a non-medical purpose. "Non-medical transportation" does not include the following:
  - (1) <u>Transportation otherwise available, or funded by</u>, <u>Ohio's medicaid program or</u> <u>another source.</u>
  - (2) <u>Transportation for a non-emergency medical purpose.</u> (See rule 173-39-02.13 of <u>the Administrative Code.</u>)
  - (3) Transportation being provided through a similar service in this chapter.
  - (4) Transportation the individual's family, neighbors, friends, or community agencies are wiling to, or required to provide to the individual free of charge.
  - (5) Escort or transportation by a participant-directed provider. (See rule 173-39-02.4 of the Administrative Code.)
- (B) Requirements for ODA-certified providers of non-medical transportation:
  - (1) The provider shall comply with the requirements for every ODA-certified provider in rule 173-39-02 of the Administrative Code.
  - (2) The provider shall comply with all requirements for ODA-certified providers of non-emergency medical transportation under paragraph (B) of rule 173-39-02.13 of the Administrative Code.
- (C) Jobs and rates for non-medical transportation follow the same standards as for nonemergency medical transportation under paragraph (C) of rule 173-39-02.13 of the Administrative Code.
