173-39-02.19 <u>ODA provider certification: Kosher kosher option for homedelivered meals.</u>

- (A) If a case manager authorizes a home-delivered meal for a consumer an individual under rule 173-39-02.14 of the Administrative Code, the consumer individual has the option to request a home-delivered kosher meal.
- (B) The provider of a home-delivered kosher meal shall comply with rule 173-39-02.14 of the Administrative Code as much as possible while complying with kosher practices for meal preparation and dietary restrictions.
- (C) The provider shall <u>furnish provide</u> evidence to ODA's designee that the home-delivered kosher meals that it <u>furnishes provides</u> are certified as kosher by a recognized kosher certification or a kosher establishment under orthodox rabbinic supervision.
