## 173-39-02.22 **ODA provider certification: waiver nursing service.**

- (A) "Waiver nursing-service" means the service defined in rule 5160-44-22 of the Administrative Code.
- (B) <u>Requirements for Every every</u> ODA-certified provider of a waiver nursing service shall comply with the following requirements:
  - (1) General requirements: The provider shall comply with the requirements for every ODA-certified agency provider in is subject to rule 173-39-02 of the Administrative Code.
  - (2) Requirements specific to a waiver nursing service: The provider shall comply with the requirements in is subject to rule 5160-44-22 of the Administrative Code.
  - (3) If a conflict exists between a requirement in rule 173-39-02 of the Administrative Code and a requirement in rule 5160-44-22 of the Administrative Code, the provider shall comply with the requirement in rule 173-39-02 of the Administrative Code instead of the conflicting requirement in rule 5160-44-22 of the Administrative Code.
- (C) Units and rates:
  - For the PASSPORT program, <u>A a</u> unit of <u>a</u> waiver nursing service under the PASSPORT program equals a unit of <u>a</u> waiver nursing service that rule 5160-46-06 of the Administrative Code establishes for the Ohio home care waiver program.
  - (2) <u>For the PASSPORT program, Rule-rule 5160-46-06 of the Administrative Code</u> establishes the maximum<u>-allowable</u> rate <del>allowable</del> for a unit of a waiver nursing service.
  - (3) <u>For the PASSPORT program, Rule rule 5160-31-07 of the Administrative Code</u> establishes rate-setting methodology for <del>units of a waiver nursing service</del>.
