ODA provider certification: Out-of-home respite services.

A provider of an out-of-home respite service to ~~consumers~~ individuals who are enrolled in the PASSPORT program shall comply with the requirements in rule 173-39-02 of the Administrative Code and the requirements for an out-of-home respite service in rule 5160-46-04 of the Administrative Code, with the following exceptions:

- (A) Only an ODA-certified agency provider shall furnish the service to ~~consumers~~ individuals who are enrolled in the PASSPORT program.
- (B) The provider shall submit all required documentation for authorizations to ODA (or ODA's designee).
- (C) "All services plan" means "service plan" as the term is defined in rule 173-39-01 of the Administrative Code.
