Receivership.

- (A) ODA shall monitor the PAA's compliance with the terms and conditions of the three party agreement between ~~ODHSOJFS~~, ODA and the PAA, and the two party agreement between ODA and the PAA.
- (B) Should ODA determine that a designated PAA has committed a substantial violation of the terms and conditions of either the three party agreement between ~~ODHSOJFS~~, ODA, and the PAA, or the two party agreement between ODA and the PAA, ODA shall request that a judge of a court of common pleas, or a judge of a probate court with appropriate jurisdiction, place the PAA's performance of that agreement into either the partial or full receivership of ODA or a receiver designated by ODA. The request for receivership shall apply only to the functions of the PAA as a PAA.
- (C) Partial or full receivership shall be defined by the court. Full receivership may be defined by the court as substituting the authority of ODA, or a receiver designated by ODA, for the authority of the governing board of the PAA insofar as that authority relates to PASSPORT administration only.
