ODA is proposing to rescind rule 173-40-05 of the Administrative Code. In doing so, ODA has 3 basic goals:

1. To eliminate an unnecessary rule. If receivership is ever warranted, Chapter 2735 of the Revised Code will grant the necessary authority, thereby negating the need for this rule. Likewise, without this rule, ODA will continue to have authority to monitor PASSPORT Administrative Agencies through the provider agreements (i.e., two-party agreements and three-party agreements) in which it enters with the PASSPORT Administrative Agencies.

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2. To comply with section 119.032 of the Revised Code, which requires each state agency to review each rule on or before the rule's designated review date.

- 3. To comply with Governor Kasich's Executive Order 2011-01K "Implementing Common Sense Business Regulation" and S.B. No. 2 (129th G.A.), which require ODA to seek the input of interested parties and the general public before filing the proposed rescission of the rule with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.
