173-40-05 **Receivership.**

- (A) ODA shall monitor the PAA's compliance with the terms and conditions of the three party agreement between ODHSODJFS, ODA and the PAA, and the two party agreement between ODA and the PAA.
- (B) Should ODA determine that a designated PAA has committed a substantial violation of the terms and conditions of either the three party agreement between ODA and the PAA, ODA, and the PAA, or the two party agreement between ODA and the PAA, ODA shall request that a judge of a court of common pleas, or a judge of a probate court with appropriate jurisdiction, place the PAA's performance of that agreement into either the partial or full receivership of ODA or a receiver designated by ODA. The request for receivership shall apply only to the functions of the PAA as a PAA.
- (C) Partial or full receivership shall be defined by the court. Full receivership may be defined by the court as substituting the authority of ODA, or a receiver designated by ODA, for the authority of the governing board of the PAA insofar as that authority relates to PASSPORT administration only.
