Sub. H.B. 66 of the 126th GA by providing that the Department or its designees will give priority for enrollment in the PASSPORT Medicaid Waiver Program to eligible persons on waiting lists who live in nursing facilities.

It is estimated that the revenues of the Department may increase during SFY '06 through SFY '07 by approximately \$10 million in State Funds and \$12 million in Federal Funds.

To pay for the PASSPORT services received by nursing facility residents who are enrolled in the PASSPORT program, section 206.66.64 of Am. Sub. H.B. 66 of the 126th General Assembly authorizes/requires the transfer of certain funds from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services' appropriations (ALI 600-525) into the Ohio Department of Aging's appropriations (ALI 490-403 and 490-607).

The funds transferred from the Department of Job and Family Services are funds that would otherwise be used by the Department of Job and Family Services to pay for services provided to residents in nursing facilities who are enrolled in the State's Medicaid program.
