173-6-01 Introduction and definitions.

- (A) <u>Introduction:</u> The rules appearing in Chapter 173-6 of the Administrative Code establish <u>This chapter establishes</u> criteria for <u>a consumer or a provider to</u> participation <u>participate</u> in the golden buckeye program by eligible individuals and providers. The program was established by <u>that</u> ODA <u>established</u> pursuant to sections 173.06 and 173.061 of the Revised Code. to assist to serve <u>The program</u> <u>serves</u> as a gateway to the following:
 - (1) Current information on services available from the aging network to support older Ohioans and their families;
 - (2) Timely information on the issues and changing needs for older Ohioans; and,
 - (3) Tangible savings and consumer benefits targeted for older Ohioans and Ohioans with a disability.

(B) As used in Chapter 173-6 of the Administrative Code Definitions for this chapter:

- (1) "Cardholder" means any individual who possesses a golden buckeye card.
- (2) "Director" means the director of ODA.
- (3) "Disability" means a total and permanent disability for a person eighteen years of age or older.
- (4) "Golden buckeye program" means the program authorized under section 173.06 of the Revised Code.
- (5) "ODA" means "the Ohio department of aging."
- (6) "Provider" means either any of the following:
 - (a) A recognized professional (e.g., an optician, a painter) who provides a benefit or discount to cardholders regarding services offered by that professional.
 - (b) A business entity (e.g., merchant, store, retail sales operation) that provides a benefit or discount to cardholders regarding consumer goods and services sold by that business entity.
 - (c) A governmental entity (e.g., a public pool) that provides a benefit or

discount to cardholders regarding goods or services that it provides.

(7) "Sign-up site" means a location where an individual may apply for a golden buckeye card. A sign-up site may include a senior center, a library, or any other location approved by ODA. Effective:
