Introduction.

The golden buckeye card program was established by the Ohio department of aging pursuant to section 173.06 of the Revised Code. The purpose of the program is to provide discounts on goods and services offered by participating merchants to any person who is a resident of Ohio and at least sixty years of age or totally and permanently disabled. The amount of the discount available for specific goods and services is determined by participating merchants. The rules appearing in Chapter 173-6 of the Administrative Code establish criteria for participation in the program by individuals and merchants.
