173-6-05 **Merchant participation.**

- (A) Merchants wishing to participate in the golden buckeye card program must complete and sign an ODA form 9002 entitled "Statement of Intent."
- (B) A completed "Statement of Intent" shall include the merchant's name, mailing address, county of location, telephone number, a brief description of the merchant's business, and the amount of the discount being offered by the merchant to participants in the golden buckeye card program. The form shall also include a statement indicating the merchant has voluntarily entered into a good faith agreement with the department of aging to honor the golden buckeye card, as well as a promise by the merchant to make no change in its regular price for goods and services prior to honoring the golden buckeye card.
- (C) A merchant may cancel its participation in the golden buckeye card program at any time by submitting a written statement to that effect to the Ohio department of aging. The department of aging may withdraw a merchant's participation in the golden buckeye card program by mailing written notice to the merchant.
