Yes. The majority of the impact to community school sponsors will be in the form of employer time for compliance. However, sponsors receive up to three (3) percent of the total amount of payments for operating expenses that each sponsored community school receives from the Department and may utilize these funds for the purposes described above. Further, sponsors regularly review and update community school contracts to account for changes in law or rule and any changes required by the amended rules could be incorporated into this process.
