**Autism Scholarship Program Established.**

(A) The purpose of these rules is to provide procedures to implement the autism scholarship program established by the General Assembly. The program shall provide to the parent of any qualified special education child a scholarship in order that he/she may receive special education and/or related services that implements the child's individualized education program (IEP) and that is operated by a school district other than the school district in which the child is entitled to attend school or by another eligible public entity, or by a registered private provider. Children attending community schools created pursuant to chapter 3314 of the Revised Code are ineligible to participate in this program.

(B) The autism scholarship program shall continue in effect for the 2004 and 2005 fiscal years.
