Definitions.

- ~~(A)~~ "Approval to operate" — a letter from the Ohio department of education to a nonpublic school indicating that the school has complied with this rule and is in the process of complying with the operating standards for Ohio's schools in order to obtain a charter.
- ~~(B)~~(A) "Charter" - ~~that~~ document issued by the state board of education to a school or school district pursuant to section 3301.16 of the Revised Code.
- (B) "Conditional charter" — a document from the Ohio department of education issued to a nonpublic school indicating that the school has complied with section 3301.16 of the Revised Code and is in the process of complying with rule 3301-35-09 of the Administrative Code.
- (C) "Department" - the Ohio department of education.
- ~~(D)~~ "Operating standards for Ohio's districts and schools" — ~~those rules contained within Chapter 3301-35 of the Administrative Code as promulgated by the state board of education pursuant to division (D) of section 3301.07 of the Revised Code.~~
- ~~(E)~~(D) "Nonpublic school" - any school, other than a public school, providing instruction for pupils of compulsory school age.
