The department has reviewed the rules setting forth the procedures for approval and oversight of nonpublic schools in Chapter 3301-39 of the Administrative Code. As part of the review, the department has sought input from the State Superintendent's Advisory Committee on Nonpublic Schools and has identified proposed amendments to the rules to streamline the chartering process. As a result of this review, language is updated, redundancies are eliminated, and the number of rules in the chapter is reduced from four to three.

The rule establishes various procedures regarding the approval of chartered nonpublic schools. The proposed changes include streamlining the regulations to require one series of public notices for the purposes of soliciting complaints regarding potential violation of the Operating Standards or policies of nondiscrimination, instead of two series of advertisements, and allowing the use of a variety of media outlets for such advertisements.
