This rule establishes the requirement for the Director to issue a ruling on the reviewability of a proposed CON project within forty-five (45) days of a request. The ruling as to whether a project is reviewable or nonreviewable shall be based upon the criteria established in rule 3701-12-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code. The rule establishes an applicant's right to appeal a ruling of nonreviewability within thirty days of the ruling's mailing date.
