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This rule describes the Certificate of Need ("CON") application review and decision process. With the approval of the Public Health Council, ODH proposes to amend the rule to comply with statutory changes requiring a comparative review process for applications as opposed to the previous practice of "batching" applications. Proposed amendments also specify that a granting or denial of an application must be made within sixty (60) days from the mailing of notice of completeness; or no later than April thirtieth, or the next business day if April thirtieth is a weekend, of the year following the year in which the application is received for applications made under a comparative review process and a notice of completeness was mailed under paragraph (K) of rule 3701-12-08 of the Administrative Code.
