As a result of recent changes to the Certificate of Need (CON) statutes and with approval of the Public Health Council, the Ohio Department of Health is seeking amendments to rule 3701-12-018.

This rule sets forth the requirements that a certificate of need ("CON") holder must follow in order to maintain the validity of the CON. The rule further describes the procedures that the Director of Health follows in order to monitor the project implementation activities of CON holders. The Public Health Council has approved amending this rule to remove a citation to section 3702.51 of the Revised Code that is no longer applicable, and to remove the requirement that the director provide notice to "other affected person" of his intent to withdraw a CON based on the applicant's failure to comply with specific requirements or provide additional information.
