This rule describes the Certificate of Need ("CON") monitoring of activities requirements for projects granted a nonreviewability ruling. ODH is proposing to

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amend this rule to decrease from ninety to sixty days the time frame the Director of Health has to correct an erroneous citation to Chapter 3701.51 of the Ohio Revised Code with a citation to section 3702.52 of the Ohio Revised Code in paragraph (D)(7) pertaining to documentation and compliance with condition in order to remain a nonreviewable activity.
