With the approval of the Public Health Council, ODH is proposing to amend this rule as part of the five year review process.

This rule lists the definitions of terms used in rules 3701-17-01 to 3701-17-26 of the Administrative Code. Amendments include various grammatical and cross citation corrections. Additionally, definitions related to dietary terms have been either added or updated, including "complex therapeutic diet" and "special diet."
