With the approval of the Public Health Council, ODH is proposing to amend this rule as part of the five year review process.

This rule esablishes the minimum personnel requirements for nursing homes, including nursing and dietary services, activities, and ancillary staff. The proposed amendments reduce the direct patient care hour requirement from 2.75 to 2.5 per resident per day, and clarify who may provide that care. Additionally, proposed changes allow homes to use two individuals as co-directors of nursing. Finally, proposed amendments require the home to post the names of the director (or co-directors) of nursing, the acting director of nursing, the name of the charge nurse, and the name of the on-call nurse.
