This rule establishes notification and reporting requirements for nursing homes when residents have a change in health status. Proposed amendments add language allowing an "other licensed health professional acting within the applicable scope of practice" to be notified or consulted in certain situations. of a resident's sponsor or authorized representative when there is a change in health status. Additionally, language regarding a resident's consent regarding health status notification has been made affirmative ("with the resident's permision") instead of "unless the resident objects."
