Public health laboratory responsibilities.

The bureau of public health laboratories shall provide screening for the presence of genetic, endocrine, or metabolic disorders in newborn children. In providing this screening, the bureau shall do all of the following:

- (A) Provide instructions for collecting, handling and transporting specimens with specimen collection kits;
- (B) Use methods for screening recommended by the United States centers for disease control and prevention or the "Association of public health laboratories" which have been approved by the director;
- (C) Complete each screen within seven business days after receiving the properly collected and submitted specimen;
- (D) Promptly transmit the results of each screen performed to the appropriate person, as specified in rule 3701-45-07 of the Administrative Code, in the manner prescribed by the director;
- (E) Keep records on each newborn child screened in the laboratory for not less than twenty-one years; and
- (F) Provide reports to the bureau of early intervention services regarding unsatisfactory specimens, disease specific reports and other reports in the manner prescribed by the director.
