3701-62-02 Authority of certified nurse practitioners, clinical nurse specialists advanced practice registered nurses, and physician assistants.

(A) A person who holds a <u>current</u>, <u>valid license</u> <u>certificate of authority to practice as a certified nurse practitioner or clinical nurse specialist</u> issued under <u>section\_Chapter 4723.424723</u>. of the Revised Code <u>to practice as an advanced practice registered nurse</u> may take any action that may be taken by an attending physician under sections 2133.21 to 2133.26 of the Revised Code and this chapter and has the immunity provided by section 2133.22 of the Revised Code and rule 3701-62-03 of the Administrative Code if the action is taken pursuant to a standard care arrangement with a collaborating physician <u>or</u>, if the APRN is a certified registered nurse anesthetist, under the supervision and direction of a physician.

(B) A person who holds a eertificate of authoritylicense to practice as a physician'sphysician assistant pursuant to Chapter 4730. of the Revised Code may take any action that may be taken by an attending physician under sections 2133.21 to 2133.26 of the Revised Code and this chapter and has the immunity provided by section 2133.22 of the Revised Code and rule 3701-62-03 of the Administrative Code if the action is taken pursuant to a physician supervisory plansupervision agreement with a supervising physician approved pursuant to section 4730.174730.19 of the Revised Code or the policies of a health care facility in which the PA is working.
