3701-62-08 Attending physician, <u>PA,or</u> CNP, or CNS as provided in rule 3701-62-02 of the Administrative Code, or health care facility unwilling or unable to comply with DNR protocol.

If a person possesses DNR identification and if the person's attending physician, $\Theta r CNP$, $\Theta r CNS$, or PA as provided in rule 3701-62-02 of the Administrative Code, or the health care facility in which the person is located is unwilling or unable to comply with the do-not-resuscitate protocol for the person, the attending physician, $\Theta r CNP$, $\Theta r CNS$, or PA as provided in rule 3701-62-02 of the Administrative Code, or the health care facility shall not prevent or attempt to prevent, or unreasonably delay or attempt to delay, the transfer of the person to a different physician, $\Theta r CNP$, $\Theta r CNS$, or PA as provided in rule 3701-62-02 of the Administrative Code, or to delay, the transfer of the person to a different physician, $\Theta r CNP$, $\Theta r CNS$, or PA as provided in rule 3701-62-02 of the Administrative Code, who will follow the protocol or to a different health care facility in which the protocol will be followed.
