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This rule defines various terms used in O.A.C. Chapter 3701-84, such as "health care service," "freestanding birthing center," "bone marrow transplantation service," "solid organ transplant service," and "adult open heart surgery service." The proposed amendment includes certain infants that were transferred from a freestanding birthing centers within the definition of "outborn infants." The rule is further amended to include a definition for "lactation consultant."
