To increase the fees for certification of certified radiation experts to cover the increase in cost of conducting this program under R.C. 3748.04 and 3748.12.

Rule prescribes requirements for certification as a radiation expert. Changes

increase the application and renewal fees for certification and increases the amount of continuing education required to renew a certified radiation expert certificate.

An increase in revenues for renewing certifications, plus some increased cost for the additional continuing education which cannot be determined since the increase will be determined by the radiation experts' choice of continuing education. The increase for the certification renewals bring revenues in line with expenditures in issuing certificates, enforcement actions and other associated duties related to monitoring this program within the Bureau of Radiation Protection.

Expenditures will be provided by funding in Fund 470, Bureau of Radiation Protection.

An increase of \$25 per certification renewal (every two years) and an increase in the cost to comply with the 10 hour increase in continuing education requirements.
