## 4112-3-04 **Reconsideration by the emmission commission.**

- (A) Procedure for applying for reconsideration. Any party may apply to the <a href="mailto:commission">commission</a> for reconsideration of a determination of probable cause or any final <a href="mailto:commission">commission</a> determination. Such application must be in writing, state specifically the grounds on which it is based, and be filed, along with all supporting materials, with the <a href="mailto:commission">commission</a> at its central office compliance department in Columbus within ten days from the date of service of the notice of determination. The <a href="mailto:commission">commission</a> shall serve notice of such application for reconsideration on all other parties to the matter in which the application for reconsideration is filed.
- (B) Determination of application for reconsideration.

The <u>commission</u> may, in its discretion, accept or reject an application for reconsideration.

- (1) If the <u>eommission</u> rejects an application for reconsideration, it shall record its action accordingly and shall notify the parties.
- (2) If the <u>commission commission</u> accepts an application for reconsideration, it shall make a determination and shall notify the parties. The <u>commission commission</u> may, in its discretion, hear one or more of the parties.
- (C) Reconsideration by motion of the <u>eommission\_commission</u>. The <u>eommission\_commission</u> may, upon its own motion, reconsider any determination. If the <u>eommission\_commission</u> reconsiders a determination on its own motion, it shall record its action accordingly and notify the parties.
