4112-3-12 **Discovery.**

- (A) Rights of discovery. ~~The~~ After issuance of a complaint and receipt of the commission's file by the commission's attorney, the commission and respondent shall both enjoy the same rights of discovery as are provided for in division (B)(3) of section 4112.04 of the Revised Code, and in rules 26 through 37, "Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure."
- (B) Civil rules govern discovery. The "Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure" governing discovery shall be applicable to discovery under this rule, except to the extent that the civil rules by their nature would be inapplicable and except to the extent that Chapter 4112. of the Revised Code provides otherwise, as in division (B)(3) of section 4112.04 of the Revised Code.
- (C) ~~Notwithstanding the above~~ Except as set forth in paragraph (A) above, a hearing examiner an administrative law judge has inherent power the discretion to control the scope of discovery, including, but not limited to, issuing protective orders on his or her own motion.
