4112-3-17 **Deferral of charges to EEOC and referral of charges to HUD.**

The commission <u>commission</u> may, without further action, defer any charge the subject matter of which is within their jurisdiction to the <u>EEOCU.S. equal employment</u> <u>opportunity commission (EEOC)</u> or refer any such charge to the <u>department of housing</u> and <u>urban developmentU.S.</u> department of housing and urban development (HUD) for investigation, findings and other proceedings. The <u>commission</u> <u>commission</u> may adopt, in whole or in part, modify or reject the findings of the EEOC and HUD and may take whatever further action as may be necessary to secure the rights of persons under, and achieve the purposes of, Chapter 4112. of the Revised Code. In the event that no further action is necessary, the <u>commission</u> shall deem its activities with respect to any charge as having terminated as of the date the charge is deferred to the EEOC or referred to HUD.
