The making and maintenance of records of the race, <u>color</u>, religion, sex, <u>military status</u>, <u>or</u>-national origin, <u>disability</u>, <u>age</u>, <u>ancestry</u>, <u>familial status</u> (housing only) or <u>marital status</u> (credit only) of applicants for employment, union membership, housing or loans relating to housing shall not violate sections 4112.02(E), and 4112.02(H)(7) or 4112.021(B)(1) of the Revised Code where <u>such the applicant is informed in writing</u> that disclosure of the information is voluntary and the records are made <u>or maintained</u> in conformance with instructions from, or the requirements of, an agency or court of the local, state, or federal government in connection with the administration of a program which serves to promote the elimination of discrimination. Such The records shall be gathered and maintained in such a fashion as to preclude their inadvertent or deliberate use for discriminatory purposes and to avoid possible misinterpretation by applicants of the purpose for which such the data will be used.
